Regina Chappell, along with her brother and sister, came to Foreverfamily at the age of six after her mother’s extensive battle with drug addiction which caused her to end up in prison. Regina spent five years in our Family Visitation Program as well as our summer camp. What Regina, now 27 years old, remembers most about her time at Foreverfamily are not just the visits with her

mom but the positive environment that Foreverfamily created for her and her siblings. “We got to experience things outside of our normal environment, opportunities that my grandmother could not afford to give us,” says Regina.

Now a wife and mother herself, Regina attributes her passion for helping and serving kids to her experiences at Foreverfamily. Regina and her husband, Quinton, are youth pastors in Spartanburg, SC serving underprivileged kids through their organization **I’ll Be (Instilling Life Lessons Beyond Environment)** which this fall provided almost 100 kids with backpacks and school supplies.

Regina and her family are the manifestations of what we had in mind when the organization was created. Foreverfamily is a place of hope, where the children we serve transcend their circumstances, and by doing so, impact our world for the better.
